## **Wayne County Board of Supervisors**

Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 21st day of February 2023, in the Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due note of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, Don Seams, Chris Moore, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dan Carpenter, Ericka Graves, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page. Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Seams made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve February 7, 2023, Minutes, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to approve February 17, 2023, payroll, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve February 21, 2023, claim set, seconded by Seams.

No Public comments on Agenda items.

Seams made motion to approve the Capital Asset deletion of 2017 Gravely 460(Trade-in \$5,800) and Capital Asset addition of 2023 Gravely 660(\$14,196), seconded by Moore.

Dan Carpenter, Assistant to Engineer reported that the PCC overlay of Hwy J-46(3-mile section east of S-40) has been let and the contract has been awarded. There has been brief contact with the contractor but there is still no expected start date. However, the late start date for the project is July 10, 2023. The bridge project on Birch being completed by Iowa Bridge & Culvert, LC has both abutments completed now, and the dirt subcontractor has done some of their work around the abutments. If there is a break in the weather the deck is ready to be poured. The road crew is still working on roadside brush grinding.

Brandon Carpenter, County Assessor presented 12 applications for tax abatement under the Rural Revitalization Plan. Moore made a motion to approve the applications, seconded by Seams.

## Supervisor meetings:

All the supervisors attended an Economic Recovery Meeting hosted by Bill Byrns, EMA Director, where the discussion was started and where counties need to have a plan of recovery after a devastating situation occurs.

Moore attended the TAC zoom meeting. TAC funding may be limited this year. Moore also spoke of House File 299 which could make public surveying more difficult if passed. Moore mentioned that the Access Management Guide is being reviewed and updated. Moore also attended an election equipment demonstration put on by Election System & Software.

Seams mentioned that Senator Sinclair and Representative Fry will be at the Corydon- Farm Bureau office on Friday, February 24th @ 8AM and encouraged the public to attend. Seams also spoke of the Governors intentions to consolidate 36 agencies down to 16. Seams attended the Veteran Affairs Meeting & Wayne County Conservation Board meeting. Conservation is always addressing the concern with ash trees. Conservation received some concrete trash receptacles from the City of Corydon, and they are very thankful for the donation and are working on sprucing them up. Moore also mentioned that Banks has finally made contact with someone in the DNR who can hopefully help improve Bob White and dredging the lake. There is a meeting scheduled for March 29<sup>th</sup> to discuss further.

Lange attended the 911 meeting and they discussed and approved the FY24 Budget. Lange also attended the Veteran Affairs Commissioner Meeting.

## Public comment:

Seams is working Kenny Banks, Conservation Director to locate a Skid steer machine for conservation. Conservation has needed a skid steer for several years because the tractor and blade are not meeting all the challenges in the parks now days. They have found several machines that are within the price range of \$40,000-\$60,000 and are well worth the investment and hopefully will leave room to purchase additional attachments.
