Wayne County Board of Supervisors

Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 21st day of March 2023, in the Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due note of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, Don Seams, Chris Moore, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dan Carpenter, Dillon Davenport, Sheriff Keith Davis, Halie Spidle, Ericka Graves, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page. Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:01AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Seams made a motion to approve the agenda with 2 additions: March 6, 2023, minutes need to be approved and the next regular board meeting needs moved to Wednesday, April 5, 2023@ 10AM, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve March 6 & 7, 2023, Minutes, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to approve March 17, 2023, payroll, seconded by Moore.

Seams made a motion to approve March 21, 2023, claim set, seconded by Moore.

No Public comments on Agenda items.

Moore made motion to approve the Capital Asset addition of 2015 CAT249D Skid steer w/bucket, forks & grapple bucket. Valued at \$52,200 with a useful life of 10years, seconded by Seams.

Moore made a motion to approve the Capital Asset deletion of #25 2019 Motor Grader, addition of (2)two- 2023 140JOY-BR Motor Grader, seconded by Seams. The second motor grader that was to be traded in was involved in a roll over accident and will be paid for by insurance claim.

Dan Carpenter, Assistant to Engineer reported that the PCC overlay of Hwy J-46(3-mile section east of S-40) has a pre-construction meeting scheduled for Friday, March 24, 2023. The late start date for this project is July 10, 2023. There will be more communication when the start date is determined. The falsework construction for the deck on the bridge project on Birch is underway. The road crew is still grinding brush in the ditches.

Moore approved the permanent Right-of-Way acquisition of P3036 bridge on Birch Road, seconded by Seams. The acquisition cost was \$4,828.20.

Halie Spidle, New Venture Group Home Administrator presented two(2) bids for removing the current drive-way, parking lot and sidewalk behind the home. Bids were Onstot Construction \$36,720 & Yoder Concrete \$37,460. Seams made motion to accept the Onstot Construction bid for \$36,720, seconded by Moore. This project is scheduled to be done before July 1, 2023.

Seams made a motion to table setting the public hearing for the FY24 County Budget, seconded by Moore. Seams expressed that there is concern with cutting the Public Health Nursing budget which will inadvertently effect the Wayne County Home Care Aide Agency (Homemakers). The Wayne County Home Care Aide Agency is scheduled to have a meeting on Thursday, March 23 @ 9AM in the Wayne County Courthouse Basement Conference room. Both agencies provide vital services that enable individuals to stay in the homes longer.

Lange made a motion to set the public hearing for the FY23 Wayne County Budget Amendment for Wednesday, April 5, 2023 @ 10AM in the Courthouse Basement Conference Room, seconded by Seams. Seams went on to explain that not all amendments effect the carry over and that some amendments are funded by other sources of revenue.

Seams made a motion to accept & approve the Recorder's February Report, seconded by Moore. Recorder deposits were \$4,459.15. Seams made a motion to accept & approve the Sheriff's February Report, seconded by Moore. Sheriff deposits were \$25,334.32. Seams made a motion to accept & approve the Clerk of Court February Report, seconded by Moore. Clerk deposits were \$498.56. Seams made a motion to accept & approve the Public Health Nursing February Report, seconded by Moore. Public Health deposits were \$49,775.64.

Seams made a motion to go into closed session per 21.5(1i) to review engineer applications, seconded by Moore.

At 11:05 Seams made a motion to come back into regular session, seconded by Moore.

Moore reported that engineer applications were reviewed, and more discussion will follow at a later date.

Moore discussed that concerns with the Old Highway 2 that was turned over to the county by the state. The Board is working with the Interim Engineer Davenport to determine the best approach to resolve the current road conditions.

Supervisor meetings:

Moore attended the Public Health Board Meeting. They discussed the financial budget and ways trim the budget moving forward. Moore also attended the Wayne/Ringgold/Decatur(WRD) Landfill meeting. They reviewed and approved new contracts for different services. Ringgold County Auditor is now acting as the Fiscal Agent for the Landfill.

Lange attended a DECAT meeting in Osceola. This board assist in keeping our youth out of the Foster Care System. He spoke about \$20 vouchers given to families to be used at the local Wal-Mart/Hy-Vee/Gas Station to provide assistance to families in need. However, he lacked seeing a checks and balance system in balance for the program. Lange also attended a meeting to discuss the growing need for childcare in the county. Currently statistics are showing that the county is short 220 spots for children needing daycare.

Seams attended a meeting with State Senator Zach Nunn where Senator Nunn shared his life experiences and his vision for helping lowa. Seams also attended the Wayne County Conservation Board meeting. Kenny Banks, Conservation Director spoke about the new skid steer and demonstrated how useful the skid steer will be regarding topping trees, clearing dead trees, smoothing out camping pads. Seams also wanted to remind everyone that Conservation is meeting with the State DNR on March 29th 10AM-12PM @ the Bobwhite Office Location. He is encouraging everyone's attendance.
