Wayne County Board of Supervisors

The Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 30th day of June 2023, in the Lower-level Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due note of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, Don Seams, Chris Moore, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Nancy Bennett, Todd Kucera, Deputy Garrett Abel, Jenny Nickell, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page. **Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.**

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda with an additional item; June 23, 2023, Claim Set, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to approve June 13, 2023, Minutes, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve June 23, 2023, Payroll, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to approve June 23, 2023, Claim Set, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve June 30, 2023, Claim Set, seconded by Seams.

No public comments on agenda items.

Lange made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the County Rural Offices of Social Services (CROSS Mental Health Region) and Wayne County for FY24 services, seconded by Moore.

Seams made a motion to table the City of Corydon Board of Adjustment appointee until the July 11, 2023, meeting, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve Wayne County Home Care Aide Agency (Homemakers) to be added to the county domain for email address, seconded by Seams.

RESOLUTION NO. 23-34 of Wayne County, Iowa regarding the purchase of Real Estate.

WHEREAS, Wayne County, lowa has determined that it is in the public interest to purchase additional real estate to be utilized by Wayne County, and

WHEREAS, there is additional real estate available for purchase adjacent to the Wayne County Sheriff's Office currently owned by Sammie Jo Michels, legally described as follows, to-wit:

The South Half of Lots 3 and 4 in Block 12 in the Original Town of Corydon, Wayne County, Iowa

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, as follows:

A public hearing regarding the purchase of the above referenced real estate by Wayne County from Sammie Jo Michels is hereby set for 10:00 A.M. on the 11th day of July 2023, at the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa. Any person who wishes to provide comments or objections to the proposed purchase of said real estate must appear at the date and time of said hearing.

Seams made a motion to approve Resolution 23-34, seconded by Moore.

RESOLUTION NO. 23-35 AMENDS THE ORIGINAL RESOLUTION 22-36 ALLOWING WAYNE COUNTY, IOWA, TO SELL REAL ESTATE FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE SENIOR CITIZENS BUILDING LOCATED IN CORYDON, IOWA TO WAYNE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE SUM OF \$1.00 FOR SPECIFIC PURPOSES FOR CHILD CARE.

WHEREAS, Wayne County Development has requested Wayne County, lowa to allow the facility be used for general economic development and not specific to child care due to the cost of renovating the facility for child care.

WHEREAS, Wayne County Development is looking to sell the facility to American Legion to support veterans.

WHEREAS, Wayne County, Iowa has determined that it is in the public interest to sell the former Senior Citizens Building located in the City of Corydon, Iowa to Wayne County Development for the sum of \$1.00 with said building to be used for general economic development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, as follows:

That Wayne County, Iowa shall sell to Wayne County Development for the sum of \$1.00 the former Senior Citizens Building located in the City of Corydon, Iowa specifically for the purposes of said building being utilized to provide general economic development.

Moore made a motion to approve Resolution 23-35, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to approve the Sheriff's May Report, seconded by Moore. Deposits totaled \$42,091.75.

Supervisors discussed Highway J46 west of Seymour is open and as well as the bridge on Birch Road.

Board of Supervisors Meetings:

Seams attended the Chariton Valley Transportation Advisory meeting (TAC). He noted that the bridge on 245th Street is approved for replacement in 2024. Seams also attended the Southern lowa Area Crime Commission (SIACC) meeting. This commission is responsible for training local jailers and dispatchers. They also provide juvenile transport. Seams attended the New Venture Waver Home meeting. The contractor for the driveway has been delayed and should start mid-July. Seams attended the County Rural Offices of Social Services (CROSS) regional meeting. The region will be joining the region with Dallas County, and the new Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for FY24 has been approved. He also discussed the CROSS region is terminating the lease agreement with the Access Center in Osceola for mental health services. The Access Center has been unable to fulfill their financial obligation and the region has been financially backfilling the commitment. There is another agency interested in leasing the facility. Seams also attended the Wayne County Home Care Aide Agency (Homemakers) meeting. The agency is operating within their budget even though referrals are down. Their staff is going to receive a pay increase starting July 1st.

Moore attended a 10-15 Transportation meeting in Ottumwa. There is still driver turnover and the ridership for Wayne County is low. Currently, 4 buses are non-operational.

Lange attended no meetings.

Public Comments:

Todd Kucera was present to discuss the best way to communicate with the Board of Supervisors when there is a pressing issue in the county that needs to be addressed before the next regular meeting. Mr. Kucera was told to call them individually and to visit with the Department Head and if he was not receiving a response to reach out to the Auditor's Office and they would relay a message to the Supervisors. Mr. Kucera then requested to be on the July 3rd agenda to discuss specific road maintenance issues.
