## **Wayne County Board of Supervisors**

The regular scheduled meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 3rd day of September 2024, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Board of Supervisor's Office, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, Chris Moore, and Todd Wilson, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Kim Crawford, Engineer Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Sheriff Keith Davis, Jon Thomas, Don Seams, Savanah Sandy, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page. **Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.** 

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Wilson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Moore.

Wilson made a motion to approve the August 20, 2024, regular meeting minutes, seconded by Moore.

Lange made a motion to approve August 30, 2024, payroll, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve September 3, 2024, claim set, seconded by Wilson.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Kim Crawford, Director of Circle of Freedom gave an update. Circle of Freedom is located in Seymour, Iowa. It provides a very structured program for women working to overcome addiction. The facility has been open almost one year. It is able to accommodate 10 women in its program at any given time. Currently, there are 3 full-time students living at the facility and enrolled in the program. Later this week, two (2) additional students will be starting the program. Over the last year there has also been seven (7) other students that have started the program but for one reason or another has not continued in the program. This is not uncommon in these types of programs. Director Crawford has also reached out to over 200 different churches and entities to secure funding for this program and is now working with several counties to secure funding through the National OPIOID Settlement they are receiving. Director Crawford is also sitting on a committee with Supervisor Wilson and Pastor Lee Havemeier to look at other opportunities to invest the OPIOID Funds in our community and surrounding communities. They are looking to team up with the school system to work on prevention with students and looking for options to support the males in our community who are struggle to addiction and leading them down a path to freedom. Possible male programs include The Refuge and Teen Challenge for Men. The county has supported Circle of Freedom with \$20,000 in Opioid funds and will be looking to support them another \$10,000 in the month of October for FY25 budget.

Lange made a motion to approve the reassignment of tax-sale certificate 12-0216 to Jerry Fetters, and the abatement of all delinquent & current taxes, penalties & interest for Parcel#12140H493008 once property ownership has transferred, seconded by Moore.

Engineer Dillon Davenport gave Engineer Office/Secondary Road Update.

- County crew is completing the shouldering project this week if they have the material. Dump trucks are scarce because of the 2 coop developments in the county.
- County crew will begin full depth concrete patching next and there is a lot to do county-wide. This project will require traffic control lights and those will be borrowed from Decatur & Appanoose County. Patches will need to cure for 24 hours before traffic is allowed on it. This cure mix will last longer but there will be some overnight lane closures.

Moore made a motion to approve Final Plans for Project# BROS-CO93(97)-8J-93, seconded by Wilson. This project is to replace a bridge northeast of Seymour on 245<sup>th</sup> Street. Engineer Davenport & Assistant Engineer Carpenter are working on Right-of-Way acquisition. The bid letting should be January 22, 2025. The project should take 3-4 months and should be completed in 2025.

Lange had no meetings to report on:

Wilson attended the 10-15 Transit Meeting. Transportation for veterans is still a concern. Wayne county does not use all of our allocation but there are other counties that are and then beyond. It was mentioned that Wayne County Veteran Affairs Service Officer, Joella Perry, has some ideas on how to improve the transportation program for veterans.

Moore had no meetings to report on.

**Discussion:** Lange reported that he had visited with Treasurer, Amanda Cooper again and she is very close to presenting the next semi-annual report.

Moore reported that the Heart of Iowa Mental Health Region is working on selecting a fiscal agent for the region and there is several options. Sheriff Davis is a member of the law enforcement committee for regionalizing mental health and hopes to have a voice in the decision-making process.

Wilson made a motion to go into closed session per code section 21.5 (1a), seconded by Moore @ 10:30AM.

Moore made a motion to come out of closed session at 11:30AM, seconded by Wilson.

Reporting back from closed session, Moore made a motion to allow Jon Thomas the authority to proceed with resolving an employee issue, seconded by Lange. Motion passed unanimously.
