

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

The regular scheduled meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 12th day of November 2024, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Lance Lange, Chris Moore, and Todd Wilson, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Kellie Anderson, Engineer Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Braxton Johnston, Don Seams, Teresa Evans, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Wilson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve October 29, 2024, regular meeting minutes, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve November 8, 2024, payroll, seconded by Moore.

Wilson made a motion to approve November 12, 2024, claim set, seconded by Moore.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport gave Engineer Office/Secondary Road Update.

- Bridge crew on 205th Street south of Edison is driving the piling
- Preliminary work is being done to move the crew to the bridge on Jubilee west of 190th Street after 205th Bridge
- Three roadside mowers are operating now. The goal is to get all pavement ditches in the county mowed fence to fence and then move to gravel roads.
- Durapatcher is making one last pass through the county before winter sets in.
- Culvert are being repaired and replaced

Moore made a motion to approve the Capital Asset Addition for the 2018 Trail King Belly Dump Trailer, seconded by Wilson. This belly dump was purchased from Rees Truck & Trailer for \$26,500 with a useful life of 6 years.

Lange made a motion to advertise for sealed bids to lease the county 225-acre farm (70 acres of hay ground and 136 acres of crop ground) located in Benton Township for 2 years, seconded by Moore. Sealed bids are due to the Auditor's office by 4PM on Monday December 9th and will be opened during the Board of Supervisors Regular meeting on December 10th. The ad will run in the county designated newspapers for 2 weeks.

Wayne County Conservation Board currently has two vacancies, from Mike Lewis and Diane Schroder-Olson stepping down from their positions. Three (3) individuals are interested in filling the vacancy. Those individuals are Brady Bloomquist, Don Seams and Tim Gaul. Wilson made a motion to appoint Don Seams and Tim Gaul to the Wayne County Conservation Board, seconded by Moore.

No action was taken on re-instating the Elected Official Compensation Board for FY26 Budget.

Lange made a motion to give Supervisor Chris Moore authority to work with the City of Millerton, The Heartland Co-op and the Legal Counsel on the details of the tax abatement for the Heartland Co-op's new facility on behalf of Wayne County, seconded by Wilson.

Department Monthly Reports

Kellie Anderson, Wayne County Development Director, reported that a local holiday shopping event is scheduled for Monday, December 2nd 5:00pm until 8:00pm. Everyone is invited to come and support local business.

Lange made a motion to approve the Recorder's October Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits were \$6,513.91.

Moore made a motion to approve the Public Health Nursing's October Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits were \$27,753.84.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Sheriff's October Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits were \$40,910.93.

Lange made a motion to approve the Clerk of Court's October Report, seconded by Moore. Deposits were \$446.07.

Auditor Dooley reported that the Board of Supervisors would be holding the County Canvass on Wednesday, November 13th at 10:00AM. Also, the ASVP (Absentee and Special Voting Precinct) Board will conduct the Post-Election Audit on Thursday, November 14th at 4:00PM. They will audit the ballots cast at the Seymour Precinct for the Offices of President/Vice President and County Sheriff.

Public Health Nursing is seeking a Registered Nurse to join their team and will be advertising. If anyone is interested, they should reach out to Susan Moore, Public Health Director.

Supervisor Meeting Updates:

Lange attended the SCICAP meeting. They are reviewing and finishing up year-end activities. Lange discussed that one of the programs that SCICAP oversees is the HeadStart Program. They are anticipating that the program will be scaled back a little bit because currently there is 180 slots for students to be enrolled but only 163 are filled. Therefore, the number of slots will be reduced. SCICAP also offers the winter Heating Assistance Program which will start very soon.

Wilson attended the Southern Iowa Workforce meeting. Their focus is on Marshalltown and Ottumwa and teaching English to individuals. Wilson also attended the Veteran Ceremony held at the Wayne Community School District.

Moore will be attending a WRD (Wayne-Ringgold-Decatur County) Landfill meeting but nothing to report today.

No Discussion items.

Public Comments: Don Seams mentioned that there will be a Craft Show at the Allerton Centennial Building on Saturday, November 30th and invited everyone to come and show their support.


