

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 7th day of July 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dan Carpenter, Don Seams, Dillon Davenport, Kellie Anderson, Stacy Gibbs, Julie Pribyl, Becky Maxwell, and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Wilson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve June 23, 2026, Regular Meeting minutes, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve July 3, 2026, payroll, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve June 30th & July 7, 2026, claim set, seconded by Lange.

No public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported:

Backhoe with mulcher head operating south of Cambria. Operator is also helping set culverts when needed.

Durapatcher working on west old Hwy 2 and then will be moving to east old Hwy 2 and then on to other pavements throughout the county.

Two mowers operating throughout the county.

The S60 highway north of Seymour is closed to traffic and will remain closed until mid-late part of July.

Subdrains and shoulder rocking should be completed this week and then the crew will move on to striping.

Department Monthly Reports:

Lange made a motion to the Sheriff's Office June Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$22,698.93.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Clerk of Court's May Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$634.37.

Discussion: Moore discussed with Matt McCall from the new auditing firm: Forvis Mazars about a report showing what Wayne County should receive from the Area VX Housing Agency for payments in lieu of taxes.

Supervisor's meetings update:

Lange attended the Chariton Valley Planning and Development meeting for COG. They discussed budget constraints since the Governor cut funding. Lange also attended the Department Head/Elected Official meeting.

Wilson at no meetings to report on.

Moore attended Public Health Nursing meeting regarding a 28E Agreement with Clarke County for nursing services.

PHN Board also voted to continue the 28E agreement for Environmental Health Services for FY27. Moore would like to see Wayne County Public Health Nursing Department is looking to submit a RFP (Request for Proposal) to be the fiscal agent for the 7-county region that is being discussed and developed. Moore would like to see the Public Health Board be reduced back down to 5 members now that the Public Health and Homemakers merge is running smooth.

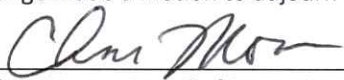

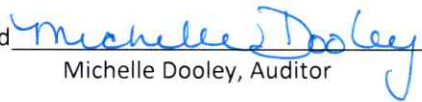
