

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 1st day of September 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: CJ McMurry, Lee Kerr, Don Seams, Becky Maxwell, Stacy Gibbs, Kellie Anderson, Kim Crawford, Dan Carpenter, Dillon Davenport and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Lange made a motion to abate the current taxes owed to the county for parcel# 007190A256008, 07180A256009, 07190A257010, 07190A257011, 07190A257012, 07190D257013, and 07190A257014, seconded by Wilson.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported that the mantis and 3 mowing tractors are out working on the brush & gravel road ditches. They are down to the last 2 districts to mow. The crew is working on the full depth concrete patching near Cambria. They will be transitioning to shouldering the paved county highways starting after Labor Day. There is routine blading and rock hauling for those not helping with the concrete patching.

Engineer Dillon Davenport is working on gathering information for the county to hire a consulting firm to review and inspect the courthouse HVAC System.
