

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 14th day of October 2025, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dan Carpenter, Dillon Davenport, Don Seams, Kenzie Miner, Becky Maxwell and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda striking item 9) Veteran Affairs Service Officer, Joella Perry to discuss/approve temporary commissioner appointment, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve September 30, 2025, Regular Meeting Minutes, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve October 10, 2025, payroll, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve October 14, 2025, claim set, seconded by Lange.

No public comments on agenda items.

Lange made a motion to open the public hearing for the FY26 County Budget Amendment, seconded by Wilson @ 10:01AM.

This budget amendment was to allow allocations of the OPIOID Funds to be sent to Circle of Freedom & The Refuge. There was no one in attendance that expressed comments for or against the amendment and no written comments were submitted to the Auditor's Office.

Lange made a motion to close the public hearing for the FY26 County Budget Amendment, seconded by Wilson.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported the following:

Secondary Road Department is back to winter hours. Monday – Friday 7:00AM to 3:30PM

Durapatcher crew is working on S60 north of Seymour to get prepared for the concrete overlay project next spring.

Culvert crew is working on a large railcar culvert replacement on Cedar Road northwest of Lineville.

The remaining secondary road crew is working on mowing fence to fence, hauling rock

The Mantis boom mower around intersections with low visibility.

Bridge contractor on 245th Street is scheduled to do their first concrete pour on Wednesday. 245th Street will probably be closed for a couple of more months for thru traffic.

Wilson made a motion to approve the FY26 County Budget Amendment, seconded by Lange.

Moore introduced RESOLUTION 26-07 (FY26 Appropriations Amendment)

A Resolution authorizing amending the appropriations for expenditures for the various Wayne County Offices and Departments for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026.

Whereas: The Wayne County Board of Supervisors approved the FY26 Wayne County Budget on April 15, 2025.

Whereas: Certain County Offices/ Departments have requested an amendment to the FY26 appropriations.

Whereas: The Wayne County Board of Supervisor published notice of FY26 budget amendment 10 to 20 days prior to holding public hearing,

Whereas: The Wayne County Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing regarding the Amendment of FY26 Wayne County Budget on October 14, 2025.

Therefore, Be It Resolved: by the Wayne County Board of Supervisors that the appropriations for expenditures for fiscal year 2025-2026, (Section 331.434(6), Code of Iowa) be amended to the following amounts as were deemed necessary for each County Office and Department. Lange made a motion to approve Resolution 26-07, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve the Capital Asset Deletion of 2021 Chevy Tahoe and the Capital Asset Addition of 2025 Chevy Tahoe patrol vehicle, seconded by Wilson. The 20221 Chevy Tahoe was traded in for a value of \$14,500 toward the 2025 Tahoe with Karl Chevrolet for \$51,464 with a 5-year useful life.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Capital Asset Addition of the 40x60 steel building with equipment & furnishings, seconded by Lange. The total cost was \$149,836.92 with a 30-year useful life.

Wilson made a motion to approve Lance Lange as the SIDCA representative, seconded by Moore.

Lange made a motion to approve the Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Area-Chief Elected Officials Shared Liability Agreement, seconded by Wilson.

Department Monthly Updates:

Wilson made a motion to approve the Recorder's September Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$5,822.09.

Lange made a motion to approve the Recorder's Quarter Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$15,082.93.

Lange made a motion to approve Public Health Nursing September Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$28,287.49.

Wilson made a motion to approve Sheriff's September Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$34,664.64.

Supervisor's meetings update:

Lange attended the Wayne County Conservation Board meeting.

The new bath house at Corydon Park is coming right along.

Some parks are closed as of October 1st but Bob White and Moore-Gosh campsites are open until 1st of November.

The board has approved installing basketball courts north of the bath house at Bob White Park next spring.

Lange also attended Wayne County Development meeting. They are restructuring and there are subcommittee meetings that are starting to be held. There are couple of new business' ribbon cuttings scheduled for later in the week; Annie's Bridal & Celebrations and LandGuys, LLC.

Wilson had no scheduled meetings to report on.

Moore discussed the Heart of Iowa Mental Health Region is still working through closing out the financials. Wayne County may be held liable for approximately \$100,000 in outstanding debt that the Heart of Iowa Region is still showing on the books even though it is not directly related to Wayne County. Moore also attended an Emergency Management Area Board meeting.

Interviews have been conducted with interested individuals for EMA Coordinator position, but EMA Commission is still working through naming a replacement of the current EMA coordinator, Bill Byrns. Byrns is scheduled to retire November 5, 2025.

Discussion Items: Auditor Dooley reminded everyone that City/School Election is November 4, 2025. That absentee voting is starting on Wednesday, October 15th to mail absentee ballots out and to vote in-person at the Auditor's Office. She also reminded everyone that Monday, October 20th @ 5PM is the deadline to submit an request form for an absentee ballot to be mailed.

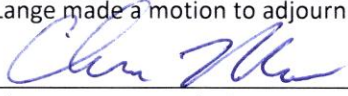

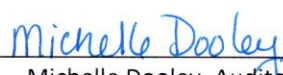
