

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 17th day of March 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Don Seams, Becky Maxwell, Leressa Lamberson, Kellie Anderson, and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Wilson made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Lange.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 3, 2026, regular meeting minutes, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve March 5, 2026, work session meeting minutes, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 13, 2026, payroll, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve March 17, 2026, claim set, seconded by Wilson.

No public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported the following:

Two new motor graders have been purchased; one will be delivered this week and the other next week.

Two new Ram 3500 pickups are on order.

No changes to the S60 overlay project schedule. April 6th the road will be closed to thru traffic, the road is scheduled to be closed for 3 months.

The reclaimer is still pulling back shoulders.

The one (1) roadside mower mowing brush around Cambria and both tree grinders are still clearing roadside ditches. One is south of Sewal the other one is Northeast of Millerton.

The mantis is in the shop getting some repair work done.

190th Street south of Hwy J46 west of Seymour has been closed by the railroad not the Engineer's Office and Engineer Davenport is getting very little answers from the railroad regarding the closure.

Moore made a motion to approve the Request for Proposal (RFP) for FY26, FY27 & FY28 Audit Services, seconded by Lange.

Dooley will be sending the RFP to the State Auditor's Office and to Forvis Mazars. Dooley also visited with Anderson Larkin Firm and Terpstra Hoke Firm about taking Wayne County on as a new client both declined at this time.

Lange visited with Brenda Fry with South Central Iowa Community Action Program (SCICAP) regarding their request for funding their beds for children project. Another SCICAP meeting is scheduled to discuss different funding sources available. Moore is willing to pledge support if funding can come from OPIOID Settlement Funds. Wilson sits on the OPIOID Committee and will research if funding can come from OPIOID Settlement Funds. Lange made a motion to table until the April 14th meeting, seconded by Moore.

Department Monthly Reports:

Wayne County Development Director, Kellie Anderson reported that the chamber is planning a spring event for May 8th from 5 to 7PM around the Corydon Square. Business owners are encouraged to reach out to Anderson for more details.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Recorder's February Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$5,423.90.

Lange made a motion to approve the Sheriff's February Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$22,761.06.

Lange made a motion to the Clerk of Court February Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$499.38.

As of February 27th the county is holding \$11,353,776.03.

Supervisor's meetings update:

Moore attended Public Health Board meeting on Monday, March 16th. As of March 2nd, Sanitarian David Rhodes is being shared

with Clarke County and will be re-evaluated after 6 months. Public Health Nursing will no longer offer free clinical services due to a shortage of medical providers for the program.

Lange attended the Wayne Community Development Corporation meeting. Lange and Anderson are working to get pledges of support for FY27 from cities and other entities.

Lange was unable to attend Conservation Meeting due to a scheduling conflict, but he reported that Director Kenny Banks and staff are working hard to get the parks ready to be reopened for the camping season.

Discussion:

Lange reported that it is not financially feasible to offer employee's an early retirement package.


