

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 9th day of June 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dillon Davenport, Don Seams, Becky Maxwell, Julie Pribyl and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve May 26, 2026, Regular Meeting minutes, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve June 5, 2026, payroll, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve June 9, 2026, claim, seconded by Wilson.

No public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported:

Culvert crew completed the railcar culvert on Ohio Rd. They are now working on 4 culverts on 200th Street north of Highway 2.

Two mowers in operation throughout the county.

Backhoe with the mulcher head operating south of Cambria.

Routine grading and rock hauling

The S60 highway north of Seymour is closed to traffic and will remain closed for 6 to 8 more weeks. Paving is going well and should be finished the week of June 14th with weather permitting. There is still subdrain and shoulder rocking that will need to be done before the highway is reopened.

Lange made a motion to table Resolution 26-30 (enter into 28E agreement with Warren County for fine collection) until the next meeting on June 23rd, seconded by Wilson.

Department Monthly Reports:

Wilson made a motion to approve the Recorder's May Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$4,669.17.

Lange made a motion to approve the Sheriff's May Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$24,190.12.

Discussion: Lange mentioned that Clarke County is looking for someone to help them with Public Health Nursing Services. Warren County has been helping Clarke County with public health but has given a termination notice effective July 1, 2026. Wayne County Public Health Administrator Susan Moore will be visiting with Clarke County more about their current needs. Currently, Wayne County is sharing sanitarian, David Rhodes with Clarke County and that arrangement is going well for all parties.

Moore discussed that there are still outstanding expenses for the Heart of Iowa Mental Health Region. Wayne County was part of this mental health region, and the state dissolved this region effective July 1, 2025. GTG Construction and Inside Out have outstanding invoices with the region and are requesting additional documentation on how decisions were made regarding making disbursements.

Supervisor's meetings update:

Lange attended the Chariton Valley Planning and Development meeting. They discussed budget constraints since the Governor cut funding. Lange also attended the Wayne County Development meeting. They have met their goals for additional funding to match county funding.

Wilson attended Eastern Iowa Workforce Development. They are working on policies and procedures. He also attended the 1015 Transit.

Moore had no scheduled meetings to report on.

Public Comments: Don Seams was asking more questions about the 28E agreement with Warren County about fine collection and the \$25,000 threshold.
