

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 14th day of April 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Don Seams, Becky Maxwell, Kellie Anderson, and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 31, 2026, regular meeting minutes, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve April 10, 2026, payroll, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve April 14, 2026, claim set plus an additional claim to First Interstate Bank for \$284.72, seconded by Lange.

No public comments on agenda items.

Wilson made a motion to open the public hearing for the FY27 County Budget, seconded by Lange at 10:02AM. There was no one present to speak for or against the proposed FY27 County Budget. There was nothing filed with the Auditor's Office for or against the proposed FY27 County Budget. Lange made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Wilson at 10:03AM.

Moore introduced Resolution 26-24 (FY27 Budget)

WHEREAS: upon due and proper notice in accordance with HF718, said Proposed FY27 Tax Levy public hearing was set and held on March 31, 2026, at 9:45AM in the Wayne County Courthouse Lower-level Conference Room, Corydon IA and residents and taxpayers were given the opportunity to present written or oral comments regarding the proposed levy rate for both General Basic Levy Rate(4.06923) and Rural Basic Levy Rate(3.79698).

And WHEREAS: upon due and proper notice in accordance with law, said Proposed FY27 County Budget public hearing was set and held on April 14, 2026, at 10AM in the Wayne County Courthouse Lower-level Conference Room, Corydon IA and residents and taxpayers were given the opportunity to present written or oral comments regarding The FY27 Wayne County Budget, for the fiscal year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: by the Board of Supervisors that the submitted and proposed FY27 Wayne County Budget is hereby approved and adopted for fiscal year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027, as entered with the Department of Management.

Lange made a motion to approve Resolution 26-24, seconded by Wilson.

Moore introduced Resolution 26-25 (FY27 Appropriations)

Resolution authorizing the appropriations for expenditures for the various Wayne County offices for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Wayne County Board of Supervisors that the appropriations for expenditures during the fiscal year 2026-2027, (Iowa Code § 331.434(6)) be approved for such amounts as deemed necessary for each County Office. The expenditure appropriations are as follows:

Lange made a motion to approve Resolution 26-25 (FY27 Appropriations), seconded by Wilson.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported the following:

One brush grinder is southwest of Millerton, and the other one is southeast of Millerton.

The mantis is southeast of Corydon.

The S60 overlay project has been postponed to the end of June or first of July.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Iowa DOT Secondary Roads Budget, seconded by Moore.

Wilson made a motion to approve the Iowa DOT Secondary Roads Five Year Program, seconded by Lange.

Bids for FY26, FY27, and FY28 Audit years were submitted by Office of Auditor of State and Forvis Mazars.

Auditor of State bid was \$62,700 for audit year ending June 30, 2026, \$65,200 for audit year ending June 30, 2027, and \$67,800 for audit year ending June 30, 2028.

Forvis Mazars bid was \$59,750 for audit year ending June 30, 2026, \$62,100 for audit year ending June 30, 2027, and \$64,400 for audit year ending June 30, 2028.

Lange made a motion to accept Forvis Mazars bid, seconded by Wilson.

Department Monthly Reports: Wayne County Development Director, Kellie Anderson reported that the Chamber was meeting at noon if anyone would like to join them. Also, there is a Spring Fling scheduled for local businesses and vendors on May 8th.

Anderson & Lange are working on the umbrella entity for the county similar to PACT Iowa which is in Appanoose County. They are visiting with the local city councils and other organizations about pledging support.

Wilson made a motion to approve Clerk of Court's March Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$947.33.

Lange made a motion to approve the Recorder's March Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$7,691.60.
 Lange made a motion to approve the Recorder's Quarterly Report, seconded by Wilson. Deposits totaled \$18,021.05.
 Wilson made a motion to approve the Sheriff's March Report, seconded by Lange. Deposits totaled \$36,923.37.
 As of 3/31/2026 Wayne County is holding \$14,736.573.

Discussion: Wilson reported that OPIOID Funds could be used for local support for the South Central Iowa Community Action Program (SCICAP) for bed project. This will be an action item at the next meeting scheduled for April 28th.

Supervisor's meetings update: Lange reported on Rathbun Land & Water Alliance meeting. A lot of funding as shifted away from tiling and terracing projects to ponds and livestock watering systems. Lange also attended Conservation meeting. There was some discussion about camp hosts at the parks. The campsites are open now and crews are still working on clearing brush. A new roof on the shop at Bob White is being discussed.

Wilson attended Chariton Valley Transportation Committee (TAC) meeting with Dan Carpenter. There is funding available for trail projects.

Moore attended EMA meeting.
