

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 31st day of March 2026, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Don Seams, Chase Clark, Becky Maxwell, Kellie Anderson, and Michelle Dooley.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:06AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Wilson made a motion to approve the agenda with the removal of item#8 Caleb Coon-Parcel#13200D276016, seconded by Lange.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 17, 2026, regular meeting minutes, seconded by Lange.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 27, 2026, payroll, seconded by Lange.

Wilson made a motion to approve March 31, 2026, claim set, seconded by Lange.

No public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported the following:

One brush grinder is northeast of Corydon and the other one is northeast of Millerton.

The mantis is on old highway 14.

The S60 overlay project has been postponed until July.

The striping project should start on the Farm to Market highways the first of May.

Lange made a motion to approve setting the FY27 county budget public hearing for Tuesday, April 14, 2026, in the lower-level conference room of the Wayne County Courthouse to start at 10AM, seconded by Wilson.

Moore made a motion to approve Dr. Ryan Arnevik, DO & Dr. Justin Morgan, DO has Deputy Medical Examiner, seconded by Lange.

Moore introduced RESOLUTION NO. 26-23

Resolution in support of Local Option Sales and Services Tax Election

WHEREAS, Chapter 423B of the Code of Iowa authorizes County Boards of Supervisors to impose a local option sales and services tax (the "Local Option Tax") within incorporated cities and the unincorporated area of counties, following an election at which the registered voters in various jurisdictions vote in favor of such tax; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 423B(4)(b) of the Code of Iowa, the question of imposing a Local Option Tax shall be submitted to eligible registered voters upon receipt by the County Commissioner of Elections of the motion or motions requesting such submission adopted by the governing body or bodies representing at least one half of the population of the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a previous election, a one-cent Local Option Tax (the "Current Tax") is currently imposed in the unincorporated portions of Wayne County, Iowa (the "County"), such Current Tax to expire on December 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to impose a new, one-cent Local Option Tax (the "New Tax"), in the unincorporated portions of the County, such tax to take effect on January 1, 2028, or as soon thereafter as is possible as a replacement for the expiring Current Tax; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to submit a motion to the Wayne County Commissioner of Elections requesting that the question of imposing the New Tax in the unincorporated County be submitted to eligible registered voters, and it is now necessary for the County to consider such a motion;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved and resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Wayne County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. This Board of Supervisors hereby expresses its support for the calling of an election in the unincorporated County on September 8, 2026, or as soon thereafter as is possible on the question of the imposition of the New Tax.

Section 2. The County shall submit this motion and resolution to the Wayne County Commissioner of Elections in satisfaction of the requirements of Section 423B(4)(b) of the Code of Iowa, requesting that the question of imposing a Local Option Tax in the unincorporated County be submitted to eligible registered voters.

Section 3. All resolutions and orders or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this resolution, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed.

Wilson made a motion to approve Resolution 26-23 in support of Local Option Sales and Services Tax Election, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve capital asset addition presented by the Auditor's Office for Tenex Electronic Pollbooks valued \$19,690 purchased from Henry M Adkins & Son, Inc with a 5-year useful life, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve capital asset addition presented by the Sheriff's Office for Taylor Power Systems Generator valued \$52,000 purchased from Interstate Power Systems with 15-year useful life, seconded by Wilson.

Wilson made a motion to approve capital asset deletion of two 2023 Cat Graders (Trade in Value \$207,155) and add two 2026 Cat Grader 140JOYBR (Purchase price after trade-in \$144,645) purchased from Ziegler with 6-year useful life, seconded by Lange.

Department Monthly Reports: Wayne County Development Director, Kellie Anderson reported that the First Thursday Coffee would be held on April 2nd @ 7:30AM. There is also a free movie on Saturday, April 4th @ 1PM at the Wayne Theater with an Easter egg hunt to follow in the courtyard.

Discussion: Aaron Hoelting is responsible for the Courthouse maintenance and custodian. He has received 2 bids for tuckpointing approximately 1,000 sq feet of the exterior of the courthouse. The board would like to give local contractors an opportunity to bid the project but understands that there may not be any local contractors interested or able to complete the project. The board would like Hoelting to determine the best contractor for the project and move forward if there is no local interest.

Supervisor's meetings update: Lange attended SCICAP meeting. Headstart will have funding for the upcoming year, and he visited with Brenda Fry about the bed program for our youth.

Wilson attended Milestone meeting, they are looking into developing new districts. He also attended an Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Area meeting where they discussed the new bi-laws for the new areas being developed. Wilson also attended 10-15 Transit meeting.

Moore attended WRD Landfill meeting. They discussed the FY27 budget. The new cell construction is completed and there will probably be a special meeting to discuss engineering cost associated with the project. Moore also attended a zoom meeting with Dorsey Whitney to discuss Local Option Sales and Service Tax which will be sunseting December 31, 2027. A special election will need to be called in September 2026 to see if the electors of Wayne County want to continue to collect the .01 cent tax to go into effect January 1, 2028.
