- G. Working with Michelle to get First Interstate Bill earlier to be able to send in with claims on time before due
- H. October 26, 2024 Camp or Treat was awesome
  - a. Over 60 kids enjoyed walking the campground to 14 decorated campers giving out treats. 65 adults were served 8 varieties of Chili soup and 3 kinds of potato soup. There were no leftovers of soup and very little of the 8 different desserts. Free will donation amount received was \$113.00. Awards went to best soup, dessert and camper.

Three drawings were held. Gift bag for one adult and one child. Two \$40.00 camping coupons were also won. Some new changes are being discussed: Start earlier, set time for drawings, set picnic tables by serving tables for diners and add a best children costume award


