

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 15th day of November 2021, in the Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were David Dotts, Tom Swearingin, Don Seams members of the Board, Tom Lenig, Wade Henderson, Aaron Hoelting, Randy Zerr, Dan Carpenter, Rhonda Bennett, Jen Reed and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their facebook page.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Dotts called meeting to order at 9:00 AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Swearingin made a motion to approve the November 15, 2021 agenda with 3 additional items; County Safety Manual, Appointment for Medical Examiner Investigator, and Tom Lenig, seconded by Seams.

Seams made motion to approve the November 1 & 8, 2021, minutes, seconded by Swearingin.

Swearingin made motion to approve the November 12, 2021, payroll, seconded by Seams.

Seams made motion to approve the November 15, 2021, claims, seconded by Swearingin.

No public comments regarding agenda items.

Randy Zerr, County Engineer spoke on behalf of Secondary Roads. The bid letting for Medicine Creek project is tomorrow, November 16, 2021. Also, he is working with the Department of Transportation on the Birch Road bridge. The letting for the bridge is scheduled for March of 2022. Zerr is recommending allow more working days for the project going into the fall of 2023 otherwise the county could see a 30% increase in the cost for the project.

Zerr also presented the Board with the 2022 annual Weed commissioner plan as well as the 2021 Weed Commissioner Report. Both documents were needing Dotts' signatures. Greg Fortune is the county weed commissioner.

Aaron Hoelting, Building & Grounds Maintenance presented two (2) options for replacing the snow blower. Vetter's has a Cub Cadet for \$899 and Gambles has a Troy Bilt for \$799. Both are 24" wide, self-propelled and 2 stage. Seams made a motion to purchase the Troy Bilt from Gambles, seconded by Swearingin.

Seams gave an update on the Humeston Congregate Senior Meal Site Program. They are currently serving 25 participants once a week on Thursday. Seams made the recommendation of allocating \$3,000 to the program.

Swearingin made a motion to approve an allocation of \$3,000 to the Humeston Senior Meal Site Program, seconded by Dotts.

Swearingin had visited with Dr. Joel Baker, The County Medical Examiner on Friday. Dr. Baker requested the Board of Supervisors approve the appointment of Chase Clark as the Medical Examiner Investigator. Swearingin made the motion to appoint Chase Clark as Medical Examiner Investigator, seconded by Seams.

Seams discussed the need for a county safety manual and volunteered to head the committee. Swearingin made a motion to appoint Don Seams to chair Safety Committee, seconded by Dotts.

Tom Lenig spoke to the Board regarding the new building blueprint and specs for Public Health Department. Lenig addressed several concerns that was not part of the spec sheet which could result in the bids varying in cost between contractors. He also addressed the need for classifying the new building based on Iowa Building Code section 302. There was discussion regarding making sure the building is ADA/HIPPA Compliant.

Lenig wants to make sure that when the bids are considered that they are comparable. At this time Lenig does not think that he will be submitting a bid for the project. Seams stated that Bickel as been in contact with the State Auditor, Rob Sand and that he has approved the use of funding for this project.

Dooley presented the 2nd Tier Canvass documents for the local school districts for the Boards review and approval for the entire jurisdiction since Wayne County is the Control County.

Swearingin made a motion to approve the 2nd Tier canvass for the November 2, 2021 for the combined City/School Election, seconded by Seams.

Seams made a motion to accept and approve the Clerk of Court's October Report, seconded by Swearingin. They deposited \$658.86.

Seams made a motion to accept and approve the County Recorder's October Report, seconded by Swearingin. They deposited \$3,959.26.

Seams made a motion to accept and approve the County Sheriff's October Report, seconded by Swearingin. They deposited \$12,588.99

Discussion

Seams reached out to Al Wilson, County Attorney for an opinion on the vaccination mandate. The threshold is 100 employees, currently as of November 12th payroll, the county has 89 employees not including Township clerks and trustees. Seams also mentioned that the county may be receiving some funding from an Opioid Settlement. Currently it is undetermined what Wayne County may receive.

Seams is going to reach out to the Seymour Community again about a Congregate Senior Meal Program. Currently the community is not offering one.

Supervisor meetings:

Swearingin attended Conservation meeting. Everything is going well there and they are preparing for winter and wrapping up some last-minute projects.

Dotts attended the SCICAP (South Central Iowa Community Action Program) meeting. They discussed their financials.

Dotts also attended the WRD (Wayne, Ringgold & Decatur County) Landfill meeting and they also discussed their financials.

Seams attended the Department Head/Elected Official Meeting along with Dotts. Seams also attended the South-Central Iowa Workforce Development CEO meeting and numerous Veteran programs held throughout the county.

Seams also attended the Iowa Workforce Local Board by Zoom where they discussed concerns about not being included in the Governor's Roundtables pertaining to workforce development.

Public Comments:

Rhonda Bennett asked the Board how they plan to handle the concerns that Tom Lenig presented to them today about bidding a new building for Public Health. Seams thought they could be addressed as the bids are submitted and reviewed.
