

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

The Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 13th day of June 2023, in the Lower-level Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due note of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, Don Seams, Chris Moore, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Nancy Bennett, Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Jenny Nickell, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page. **Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.**

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Seams made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Moore.

Lange made a motion to approve May 30, 2023, Minutes, seconded by Moore.

Seams made a motion to approve June 9, 2023, Payroll, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve June 13, 2023, Claim Set, seconded by Seams.

No public comments on agenda items.

Dillon Davenport, County Engineer gave an update on the Secondary Roads Department.

The Sunny Slope bridge is ready for additional pilings to be driven when crane operator is available. Roadside mowers are being rotated around the county per blade districts. The culvert crew is back laying pipes. The Birch Bridge dirt work will be done this week and the guard rail next week. Hoping to reopen Birch bridge in the next 2 weeks and seeding will be done in the fall. The contractor on the J46 concrete overlay project has completed the overlay, tile and drainage. They are now working on shouldering and will finish up with painting.

From the ICIT assessment, the county is highly encouraged to hire a full-time IT Director. Seams made a motion to approve the job description for a new IT Director with a starting salary of \$75,000 and must live within a 30-mile radius of Corydon, seconded by Moore contingent upon Jack Reeds approval of Job Description. Salary, vacation and sick leave may be negotiated based on experience.

Moore made a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Management (DOM), Iowa Office of the Chief Information Officer and Wayne County to provide CrowdStrike services, seconded by Seams. CrowdStrike is designed to guard against cyber attacks that would adversely impact the County's ability to deliver critical services.

Moore made a motion to approve the purchase and installation of the new server operating system, seconded by Seams.

Lange made a motion to approve Wayne County employees to split their payroll direct deposit between three (3) separate accounts, seconded by Moore.

Seams made a motion to accept and approve the Recorder's May Report, seconded by Moore. Deposits totaled \$7,051.96.

Seams made a motion to accept and approve the Clerk of Court's May Report, seconded by Moore. Deposits totaled \$982.59.

No Discussion Items

Board of Supervisors Meetings:

Seams attended the County Rural Offices of Social Services (CROSS) regional meeting. The region will be joining the region with Dallas County, and they are still working on the wording for the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and the 28E Agreement between the new region and the participating counties. Seams also attended the 6-month strategic review with Scantron Technology and another meeting with the new Regional Sales Manager, Pat Heller. Seams has addressed a finding involving the Board of Supervisor’s printer. Scantron is working on cleaning up Wifi access points. Seams also attended the conservation board meeting. Kenny Banks and his team are doing very well. The skid steer is working well for conservation and the campsites are looking good. They are holding off on removing some trees until colder weather. They have some volunteers helping to mow. The state has approved a basketball court at Bob White and the Conservation Board is working on financing. Humeston Lake has been restocked with fish. There are some sewer and water lines that need to be repaired. Camping Fees are increasing to \$20 per night on July 1st, 2023.

Seams, Moore and Lange all attended a Department Head/Elected Official meeting on June 7th with Andrew De Haan, along with some of the ICIT assessment team. Jess Flaherty, with the Dept. of Management; Office of Chief Information Officer to speak of IT services offered to counties funded by the State. OCIO is strongly encouraging Wayne County to participate in the CrowdStrike initiatives which is free to counties.

Public Comments:

Nancy Bennett, Wayne County Development Interim Director was present to give an update on The Walldog Event. Donations are still coming in. The Scavenger Hunt on June 10 was a great success, and she was very thankful for everyone who helped with the event. Currently, there are 150 artists who have signed up to attend the Walldog Event in August. The committee is still looking for individuals who are willing to open their homes to the artist or offer their travel trailers to be parked at the fairgrounds for artist to stay in. There will also be a need for volunteers to help during the actual event. If you or someone you know is interested in helping, please reach out to the Wayne County Development Corporation and visit with Nancy. Auditor Dooley also mentioned that she has one quote for scraping and painting the courthouse and is expecting another one very soon. When she has received them both, she will present them to the Board for their review. Jenny Nickell also asked who maintains the rock roads that are shared between the City of Allerton and the County. Moore was aware of the situation, and it has been discussed with the Engineer’s Office. Engineer Davenport will review the 28E agreements on file with the different incorporated areas throughout the county and will try to get clarification.
