A Seat on the Wayne County Board of Supervisors has become vacant by resignation of Don Seams effective July 7, 2023.

The Vacancy Committee consisting of the County Treasurer, Recorder & Auditor pursuant of Iowa code Section 69.8(4)

has called for a special election to fill the remaining balance of the unexpired term of office.

Special Election will be held on **Tuesday, October 3, 2023.**

Additional publication will be given of the Election not less than four (4) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date of election.

Filing Dates & Nomination Process:

Candidate filing period starts immediately and will run through Friday, September 8, 2023 @ 5PM Candidate Filing Officer is the Wayne County Auditor.

Candidate Nomination Options:

Political Party Candidates

For Special Partisan Elections there is no Primary Election so political parties must nominate candidates by reconvening the county convention as outlined in Iowa Code 43.78.

Non-Political Party Organizations (NPPO) Candidates

For Special Partisan Elections NNPOs may nominate candidates either by holding a nominating convention or by circulating nomination petitions as outlined in Iowa Code 44.1.

"Nominated by Petition" Candidates

For Special Partisan Elections candidates who want to appear on the ballot followed by the words "nominated by Petition" must file nomination petitions and affidavits of candidacy. Nomination petitions which contain signatures of eligible electors residing in the county equal to at least one percent (1%) of the number of registered voters in the county on July 1 in the year before the year in which the office will appear on the ballot or by at least 250 eligible electors, whichever is less as outlined in Iowa Code 45.1. Registered voters in Wayne County 3828 * 1%=39 minimum required signatures for nomination petition.
