

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

The Regular Scheduled Meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 5th day of September 2023, in the Lower-level Conference Room of the Wayne County Courthouse, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present were Lance Lange, and Chris Moore, members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dillon Davenport, Dan Carpenter, Don Seams, Jenny Nickell, and Michelle Dooley.

The Corydon Times Republican live streams the Board of Supervisors regular session meetings on their Facebook page.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Lange called the meeting to order at 10:00AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve August 22, 2023, Minutes, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve September 1, 2023, Payroll, seconded by Moore.

Moore made a motion to approve September 5, 2023, Claim Set, seconded by Lange.

No public comments on agenda items.

Engineer Dillon Davenport reported that motor grader training will be held September 6 & 7th with Brian Jackson. The training will be done on 110th Street by the old county home. That road will be closed during the day for the training. The pile driver has been assembled and is ready to be shipped. Crews are still out mowing and grinding the road ditches and are currently working north of Highway 2 on 170th.

Moore made a motion to approve the property tax abatement request from the City of Humeston on Parcel # 01150E312005 & 01150F331003 totaling \$426, seconded by Lange.

Lange made a motion to approve the Capital Asset Addition of real estate purchased from Sammie Jo Michels for \$40,000, seconded by Moore.

Wayne County Bible Reading on the Courthouse lawn will take place September 7-11, 2023.

No Department Reports.

Lange attended the COG meeting which is part of the Chariton Valley Development. The committee will not be purchasing any additional homes for the New Haven Subdivision until two (2) homes that are finished are sold. Lange also attended the Southern Iowa Workforce Development training.

Moore attended the CROSS meeting for mental health. The region has hired a couple of new employees as a result of the restructuring of regions and new fiscal agents. The CROSS region is still working on details regarding the access center building in Osceola. Moore was unable to attend the 1015 Transit meeting but reported that Wayne County's ridership is still the lowest of all the counties participating in the program. Very little changes from meeting to meeting. A few buses have broken down. They are waiting to be repaired. Additional drivers are needed.

Discussion items

Ruiz Construction has completed the courthouse exterior painting. They have done an exceptional job.

Engineer Davenport has tinted their office windows and the county should look at doing more windows next year after the HVAC project is completed.

Public Comments: Don Seams asked if there has been any progress resolving the litigations with the Access Center in Osceola. Moore responded that they are still discussing and went into closed session during the last CROSS meeting.
