Wayne County Public Health is partnering with Vision to Learn Iowa and all three school districts to provide vision screenings to all students in K thru 12th grades. The first phase of the project is the initial screening which is being completed by Wayne County Public Health Staff. We will be done with screenings at Seymour and Mormon Trail Schools by the first of November if not sooner. Then we will refer the students who need an exam by an eye doctor to Vision to Learn who then are planning to bring their van and staff to Seymour before Thanksgiving then to Mormon Trail between Thanksgiving and Christmas. We will begin screening Wayne Community School students in early January 2024. Funding for the project is being provided by different service groups and private citizens in Humeston for the Mormon Trail School and the Wayne Community Foundation and citizens for the Seymour and Wayne Community schools. We are very proud of this project as Vision to Learn Iowa has never done one in a rural area of the state and on such a large scale.
