A special meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 25th day of February 2025, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange (via phone) members of the Board. Also in attendance: Don Seams, Savannah Sandy, Chase Clark, and Michelle Dooley.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:02AM and took roll call.
