

Wayne County Board of Supervisors

A regular meeting of the Wayne County Board of Supervisors was held on the 9th day of December 2025, at the Wayne County Courthouse in the Lower-Level Conference Room, Corydon, Iowa, pursuant to notice duly given in compliance with the Iowa Code Section 21.4. The Board noted due notice of meeting subject to said Code Section.

Present- Chris Moore, Todd Wilson, and Lance Lange members of the Board. Also in attendance: Dan Carpenter, Dillon Davenport, Don Seams, Kenzie Miner, Stacy Gibbs, Kellie Anderson, Ryan Berven, Eric Willis, Michelle Dooley, and Tiena Lewis.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions are approved unanimously by all Board members present.

Moore called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM and took roll call.

Pledge of Allegiance

Lange made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition of the 4th parcel for the City of Corydon's request for tax abatement, seconded by Wilson.

Lange made a motion to approve Nov. 25, 2025, regular meeting minutes, Wilson seconded.

Wilson made a motion to approve Dec. 5, 2025, payroll, Lange seconded.

Lange made a motion to approve Dec. 9, 2025, claim set, Wilson seconded.

Public Comment: none

Engineer Update: Rocking will be done at the Lineville Tank Car culvert project on Cedar Rd. today. More rip rap will be placed, and a sheet pile wind wall will be built to try to keep the channel in line at the entrance of the culvert. Seeding will be done next spring. The 245th Street bridge south of Highway 2 should have deck steel should be done tomorrow but will have to wait for warmer weather to pour the deck. Until weather changes, the bridge project will be slow. Contracts for the overlay on S60 Highway and the county wide center line painting will both be let on Dec. 16th, 2025, at the IA DOT.

Lange made a motion to approve the City of Corydon tax abatement request for present and future taxes, penalties, and interest for parcels # 06240D227001, 06240D227002, 06240D227003 and 06240D227006, seconded by Wilson.

Ryan Berven and Eric Willis presented information about the FY27 renewal insurance rates. It was noted that our rates were lowered partially due to receiving 5% reduction due to employee participation in the wellness program, but Ryan suggested keeping the same budgeted rates to help build up our partial self-funding account.

Lange made a motion to approve the Eastern Iowa Workforce Development Area Chief Elected Officials Shared Liability Agreement after changes to the wording were made, Wilson seconded.

Anderson stated that Saturday will be the Wayne County Holiday event, which includes small business shopping, lighted parade, Santa visit, and free movie.

Supervisor's meetings update: Lange could not attend the Conservation meeting but talked to Kenny and gave an update on the Corydon Lake Park project. Lange also stated that the time clock was ordered for Conservation.

Wilson attended the Eastern Iowa Workforce Development meeting where the liability agreement was discussed.

Moore attended a zoom meeting for Lost fund future and details on what he had learned at the meeting were discussed.

Public Comments: Seams asked the board if two resolutions were required for the Lost fund in the upcoming General Election. There was discussion about the Lost fund resolutions. Seams also asked if the Compensation Board will be having a meeting in the future and about status of the lawsuit against county. Lewis presented a thank you card from the Seymour Food Pantry. Dooley informed the board that Sheryl Dotts had accepted the drawn lot position of the council member for the City of Seymour.
