Wayne County Emergency Management and Chariton Valley Planning & Development Council of Governments are collaborating to update the county's Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Hazard Mitigation planning reduces the loss of life and property by minimizing the impact of disasters. After identifying risks that can occur, long-term strategies are developed for protecting people and property from events. Mitigation plans are key to breaking the cycle of disaster damage and reconstruction.

This is a community-guided document. Community participation is vital to the success of the plan. Every community in Wayne County will need to be involved in this process to be eligible for any funding that should become available. Residents, communities, schools, fire departments, hospitals and more are invited to participate in this process by attending meetings and providing information for the plan.
