Walldog Culture Trail: The freestanding structure has been removed and the area has been cleaned up. We are currently waiting to hear from Jim regarding the timeline for installation at the fire station. The Lineville structure will be repurposed for use in Allerton. Because the building at the Inn of Six Toed Cat cannot support the mural, the mural panels will be removed and be mounted on the wood structure and displayed next to the inn.
